"We will celebrate Christy, Peggy and Quarles & Brady, and also the impact the program has had in furthering the education of young women over the past 26 years."

Each Mentor Award recipient will receive a \$5,000 scholarship, made possible through the TEMPO Milwaukee Foundation, to be provided to a Wisconsin college or university of choice in their name. Each scholarship will be awarded to a female student who shows ongoing commitment to leadership. TEMPO Milwaukee has provided more than \$200,000 in scholarships to approximately 66 Wisconsin women since 1990.

In 1990, TEMPO Milwaukee established the Mentor Awards event to recognize individuals and organizations in the community dedicated to the mentoring of others. Mentor Award recipients are nominated each fall by individuals within the Milwaukee community.

Nominations are then judged on three criteria: mentoring of others, business leadership and community leadership.
