MILWAUKEE—(March 21, 2018) —TEMPO Milwaukee is pleased to announce that its Emerging Women Leaders initiative has passed 100 in membership, just two years after it was established.

TEMPO Milwaukee launched the Emerging Women Leaders (EWL) initiative in December 2015 to support the area's growing pool of professional women who are in mid-career and heading for the executive ranks.
