

TEMPO MILWAUKEE

Founded in 1975, TEMPO Milwaukee is a professional networking organization for Milwaukee businesswomen in senior leadership, C-Suite and executive-level roles. The typical TEMPO Milwaukee member is a senior leader within her company/organization with at least five years of experience in a senior-level role. Members are highly active in the community, serving in leadership roles on boards, committees, etc. TEMPO Milwaukee's 370+ members join the organization for leadership, networking and mentoring opportunities among their peer group - women who have reached or will soon reach the pinnacle of their careers.

CRITERIA:

- 10+ years of professional experience.
- 5+ years of senior/executive-level or high managerial experience.
- One of her organization's top executives or has direct working involvement with top executives.
- Demonstrates commitment to the community through involvement and leadership in professional and/or civic organizations.
- Strong nomination from a current TEMPO Milwaukee member who is familiar with the membership criteria.



EMERGING WOMEN LEADERS (EWL)

Founded in 2015, EWL represents the next generation of Milwaukee's female leaders and executives. Emerging Women Leaders join the organization for professional development, mentoring, community involvement and networking opportunities with their peer group, as well as with TEMPO Milwaukee members at select events. EWL participants can be nominated for TEMPO Milwaukee membership once they meet the 10+ years of professional experience/5+ years of senior leadership experience requirements.

CRITERIA:

- 6+ years in the workforce in a professional setting (time spent as an intern does not apply) with increasing responsibilities. During this time, she has developed a reputation as a "rising star," next generation leader, on the partner track, etc.
- Demonstrates commitment to the community through involvement and leadership in professional and/or civic organizations. Involvement is above and beyond required job responsibilities.
- Displays leadership within her company/organization; a letter of support from the nominee's supervisor or other company leader is required.
- Strong nomination from a current TEMPO Milwaukee member or Emerging Women Leader who is familiar with the program.
